Based within the Masai Mara National Reserve, on Paradise Plains. The Mobile Expeditions camp sits on the banks of the Mara River beneath a riverine forest.

The Camp is accessible by road, or by air.

Guests can fly by charter or scheduled flight to

Musiara Airstrip where we will collect them.

Family History

Willie Roberts, the founder of Mobile Expeditions and Caro's father, was a true visionary and one of the forefathers and most instrumental ambassadors of wildlife conservation in Kenya. He set up the first Wildlife Conservancy in Kenya in the Maasai Mara, essentially founding the 'conservancy movement', saving the greater area from being carved up for farming, laying down a clear path of success for community conservancies in Kenya and setting an example and an inspiration for others to follow.

Willie's key eye for detail and passion for luxury safari also laid the way for him and his wife Sue, to start Sirikoi - one of Kenya's leading lodges.








Luxury Amenities

Each Room is fitted with luxury amenities, including flushing toilets, en suite shower and basin.


The beds are fitted with high-quality white linen. We provide guests with luxury, locally produced toiletries.

The camp is a luxury, tented camp overlooking the Mara River. This small, intimate camp has its own unique charm that embraces its surroundings.






Dining

Dining Al Fresco means that our guests are able to take in the sounds of the bush, watching elephant browse the river or birds calling the song of the wild.


Dining can be done communal with hosts or privately.

Most of our team are Maasai people from the area and our ambition is to build career opportunities and to support local traditions.



Your Safari

Safaris are done in exclusive vehicles with both a local guide and spotter to ensure that no wildlife opportunities are missed.

Your safari can be done at your own pace, whether you are looking for a full days exploration, or even just a couple of hours in the morning or evening. We will design your ultimate safari according your desires.




Exclusive Use
